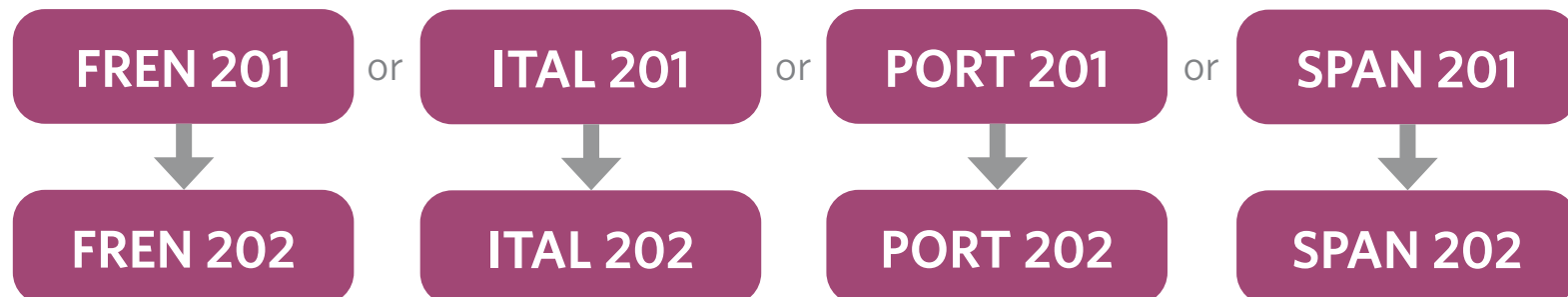
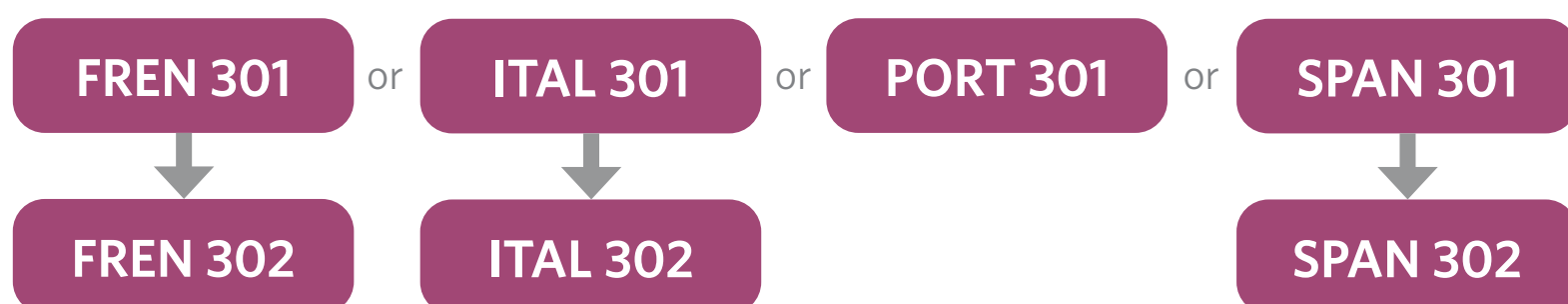


# HONOURS IN ROMANCE STUDIES

6 CREDITS | 2 courses chosen from any of the following 200-level language courses<sup>1</sup>:

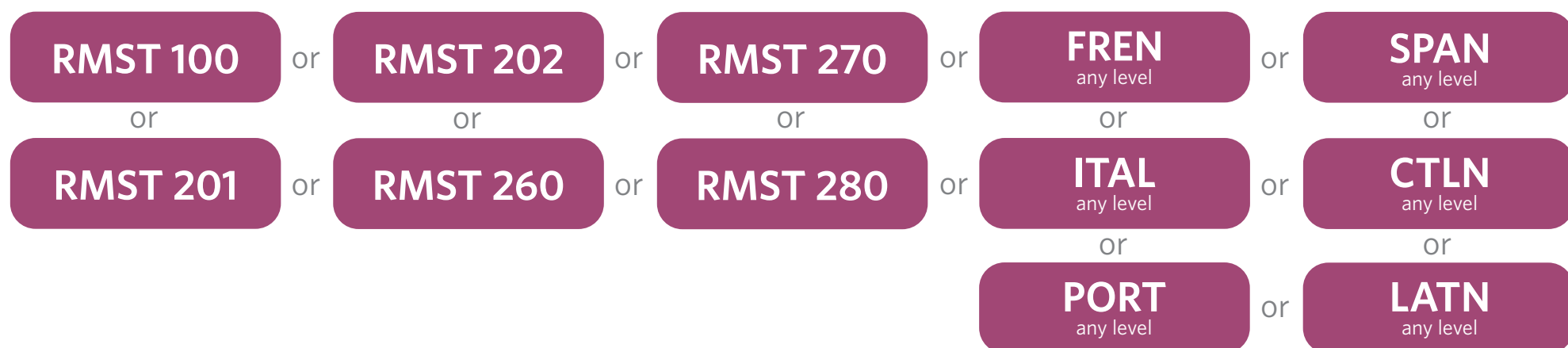


6 CREDITS | 2 courses chosen from any of the following 300-level language courses<sup>2</sup>:



Elective course requirements can also be fulfilled by language, literature, and culture classes taught in the target language (French, Italian, Spanish or other approved Romance languages) when students meet the necessary proficiency requirements in that language.

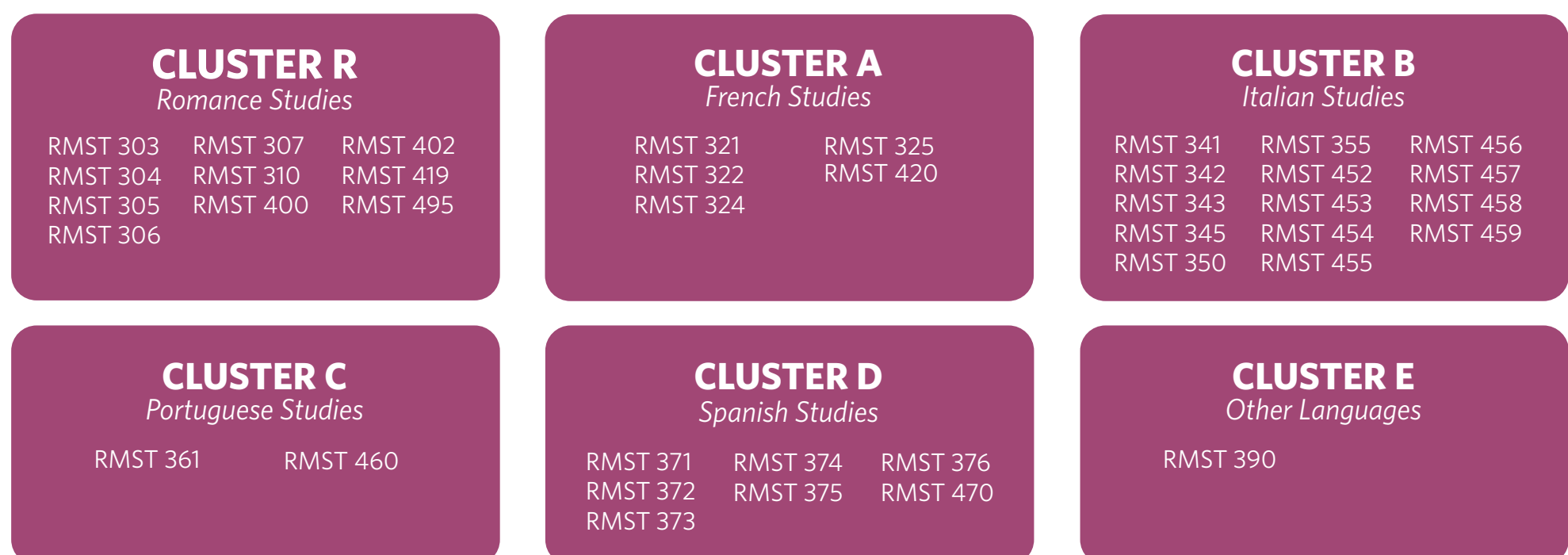
6 CREDITS | 2 courses chosen from any of the following 200-level RMST courses or language courses:



12 CREDITS | Take all 4 of these required courses:



30 CREDITS | 10 courses chosen from at least 2 clusters:



<sup>1</sup> Students may be exempt from this requirement if they already have a proficiency level of A2 on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) in one of the Romance languages.

<sup>2</sup> If students already have 300-level proficiency in one Romance language, they must take 6 credits in another Romance language or upper-level literature/culture course.
