SUMMER SCHOOL FRENCH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE

Are you over 18, wanting to improve your French and extend your knowledge of French culture? If you are, come discover Lyon and its region, regardless of your level of proficiency in French.

At our Summer School, project-based learning and interaction are at the heart of the Language and Culture Program. After the initial placement test, you will join a group that corresponds exactly with your level of proficiency. In the mornings, language courses will help you develop written and oral skills in comprehension and expression and acquire linguistic tools.

In the afternoons, you will work on creating collaborative projects – an exhibition, performance, film, photo novel - to share with all the participants at the end of the course. You will choose two projects to work on during the month, alternating between the two, alongside groups of the same or compatible language levels: A1/A2, B1/B2, B2+/C2.

In parallel with classes, the CIEF Leisure service organises cultural outings and field trips in Lyon and its region (local gastronomy, the Festival d'Avignon, visits to Annecy for example). Some activities are subject to a fee and must be booked in advance: this information is given at the time of registration. Outings in Lyon take place during the week after classes and trips further afield take place at weekends.

At the end of the programme, participants receive a certificate with details of their results.

WELCOME SERVICES AND ACCOMMODATION

Lyon offers many possibilities for accommodation, but demand is often high. If you wish, you can apply for low-rent accommodation in university halls of residence, in a single room, studio or shared apartment. We cannot guarantee the availability of such accommodation, but we can generally satisfy requests made before May 15th.

You must indicate your preference on the preenrolment form. You will find general information on accommodation and costs on the CIEF website.

For groups of at least ten people, a pick-up service can be provided, for a fee, at Lyon Saint-Exupéry airport, or at the train stations of Lyon-Perrache or Part-Dieu.

- a higher education qualification OR
- passed the university entry exam in their home country



CIEF diplomas are based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFRL) of the Council of Europe.

Most courses are offered at all levels of the CEFRL, but some university diplomas require prior knowledge and a specific level of French. Please refer to the online course descriptions.
