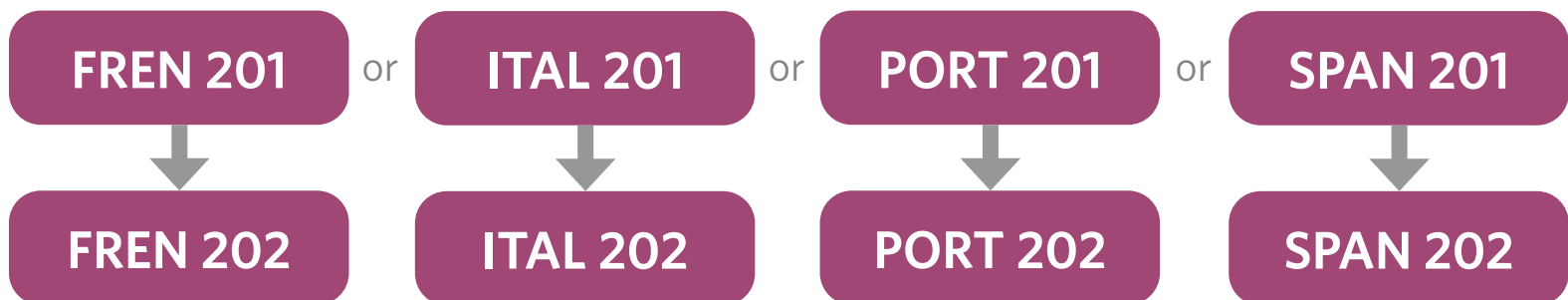


# MAJOR IN ROMANCE STUDIES

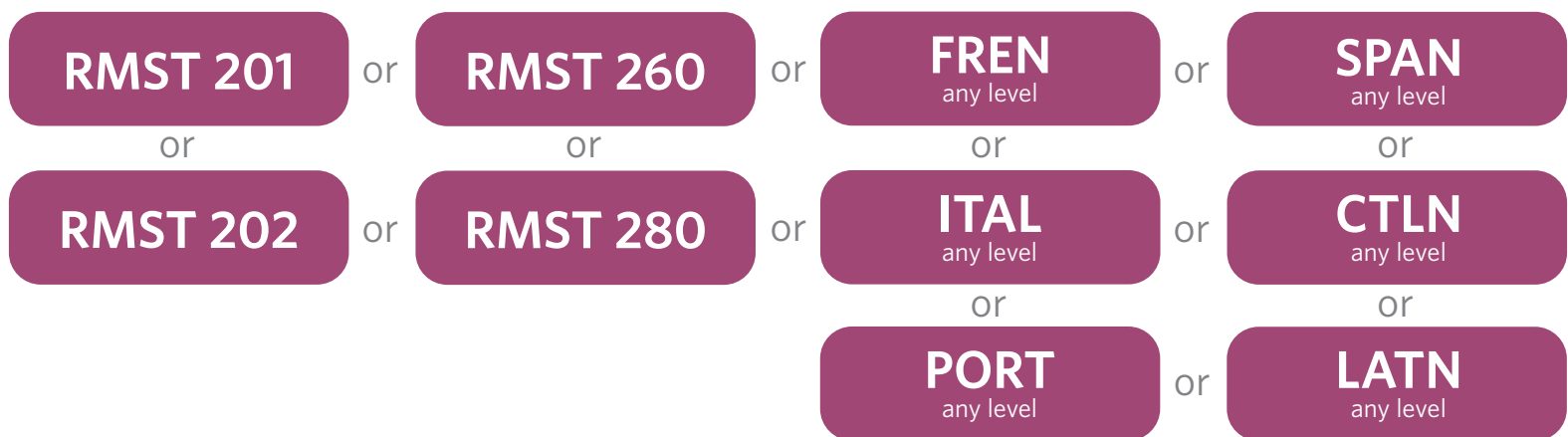
## 6 CREDITS | 2 courses chosen from any of the following 200-level language courses<sup>1</sup>:

<sup>1</sup> Students may be exempt from this requirement if they already have a proficiency level of A2 on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) in one of the Romance languages.



## 6 CREDITS | 2 courses chosen from any of the following 200-level RMST courses or language courses<sup>2</sup>:

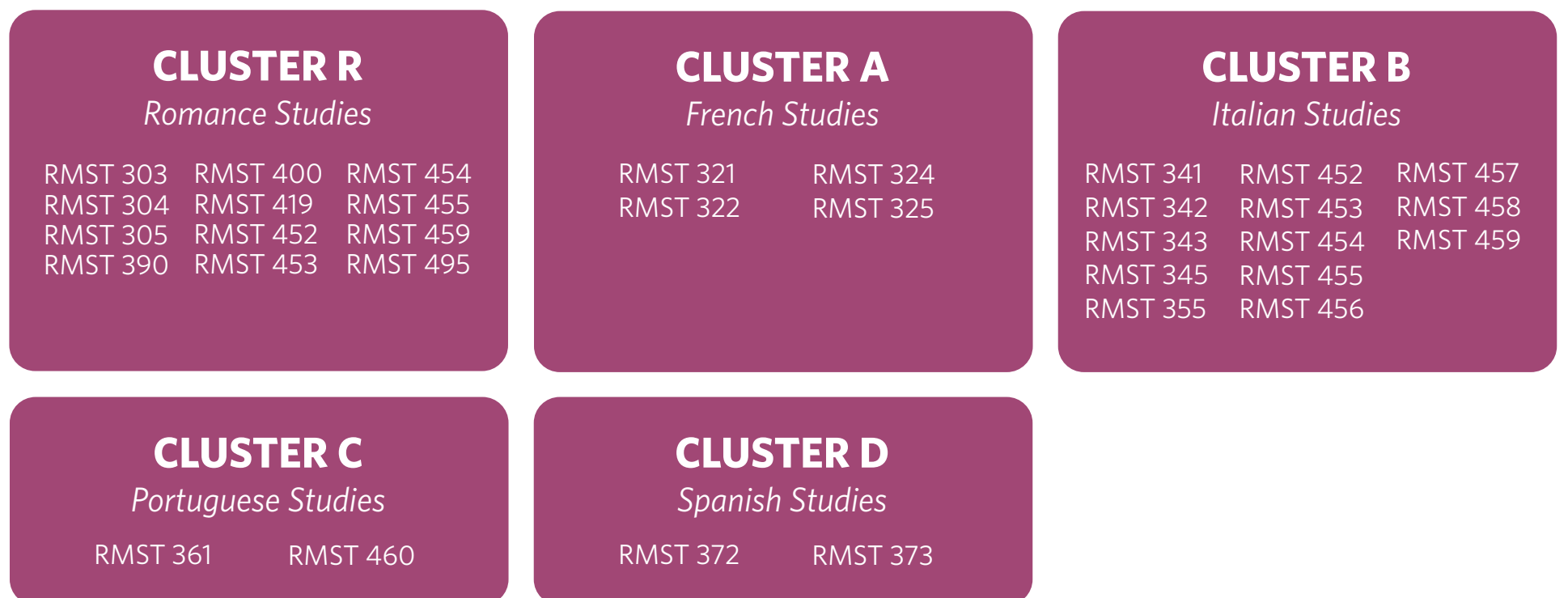
<sup>2</sup> These 6 credits cannot be exempt even though students already have a proficiency level of A2 on CEFR in one language. For example, if a student has a A2 level in French, this student can choose to take upper level courses in French OR can also take lower level courses in one or several other Romance languages.



## 9 CREDITS | Take all 3 of these required courses:



## 21 CREDITS | 7 courses chosen from at least 2 clusters:



Elective course requirements can also be fulfilled by language, literature, and culture classes taught in the target language (French, Italian, Spanish or other approved Romance languages) when students meet the necessary proficiency requirements in that language.
