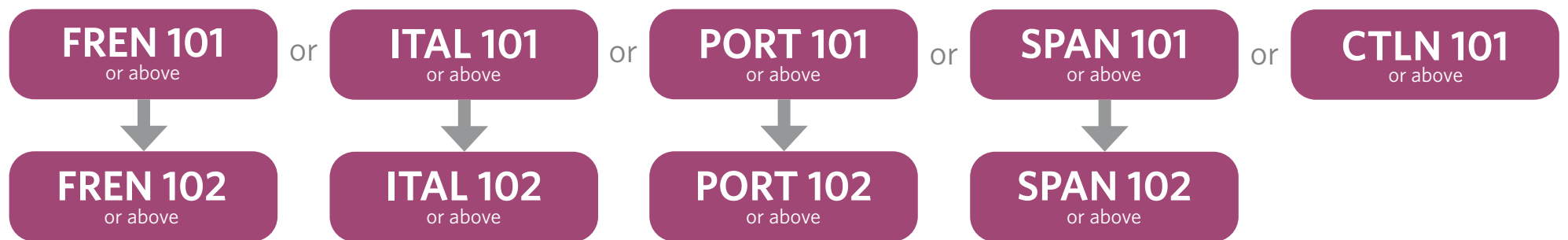


# MINOR IN ROMANCE STUDIES

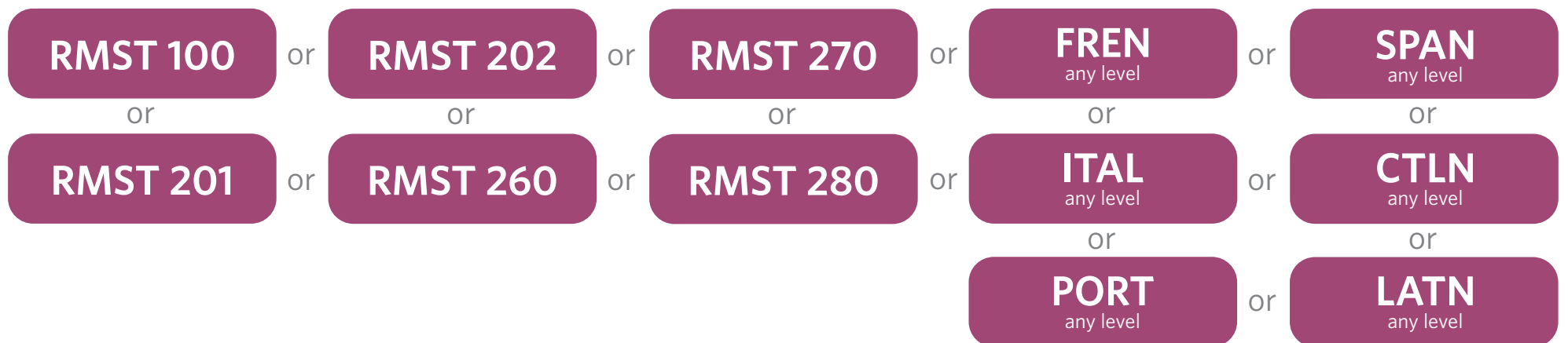
## 6 CREDITS | 2 language courses that are 100-level or above<sup>1</sup>:

<sup>1</sup> Students may be exempt from this requirement if they already have a proficiency level of A1 on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) in one of the Romance languages.



## 6 CREDITS | 2 courses chosen from any of the following language courses or 200-level RMST courses<sup>2</sup>:

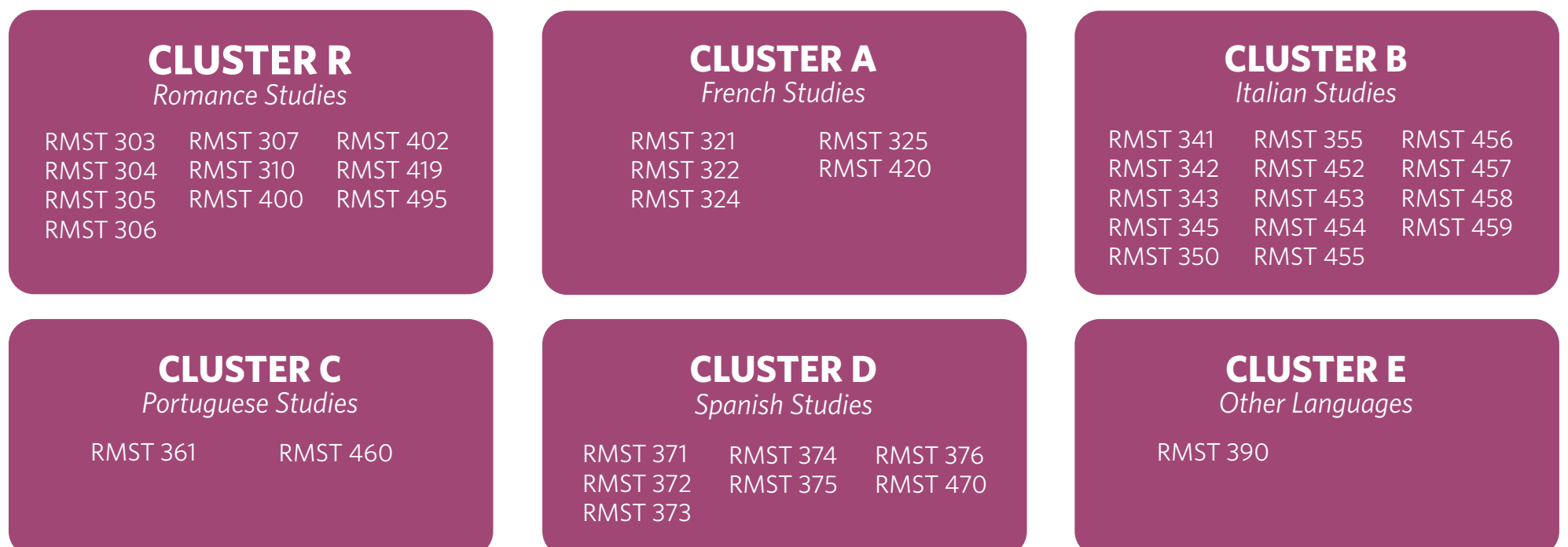
<sup>2</sup> These 6 credits cannot be exempt even though students already have a proficiency level of A1 on CEFR in one language. For example, if a student completed Grade 11 Core French or FREN 102, this student can choose to take more courses in French OR can also take lower level courses in one or several other Romance languages.

## 9 CREDITS | 3 courses chosen from at least 2 clusters:



Elective course requirements can also be fulfilled by language, literature, and culture classes taught in the target language (French, Italian, Spanish or other approved Romance languages) when students meet the necessary proficiency requirements in that language.
